

Injection Techniques*

for ER formulations in Cats and Dogs

Subcutaneous Injection Procedure

1. Form a “tee-pee” with the loose fold of skin by pinching the animal’s scruff and lifting the skin away from their body.
2. There should be a slight indentation in the animal’s scruff directly below your pinched fingers, where the needle will be inserted.
3. Insert the needle carefully into the indentation on the fold of loose skin held between your fingers.
4. Proceed to squeeze the plunger on the syringe firmly but not too quickly, giving the injection at a moderate speed, with care.
